This information will be kept on our waiting list database until offered a berth or until a time you request for your information to be removed and deleted from our database.

Use of Information

The information that you provided for the waiting list is stored and used internally only for the purpose of fulfilling your request and for contacting you directly. The information will not be passed to a Third Party nor used for marketing purposes. Personal information will be removed and deleted once you are no longer a customer at Lossiemouth Marina.

Personal information for visitors is required for the duration of stay only and will be deleted once the vessel has departed the marina. Vessel information is requested for statistical reasons only.

New permanent customers of Elgin and Lossiemouth Harbour Company will be given the option to opt in to receiving newsletters and marketing information about our undercover workshops.

Customers at Lossiemouth Marina have the right to access or request erasure of personal information.
