**PIER-BASED BUCKET DREDGE OPERATIONS –
VISITOR BERTHS AND WEST BASIN CHANNEL**

Mariners, residents, commercial tenants and members of the public are advised of dredging operations via a pier-based crane and bucket dredge within the visitor berth area and the west basin channel.

This will be completed over three phases, commencing 24 March 2026.

Phase one: Visitor berth area and east basin

Phase two: West basin channel

Phase three: East basin central – late April

Each phase is expected to last no longer than one week.

Operations are weather dependent and subject to change.

This temporary method will affect access as follows:

- **Mariners – restricted access within the east basin and to the west basin channel during times of dredging.**
- **Members of the public – restricted access for pedestrians and vehicular traffic to the tower at the east basin. Also restricted in the vicinity of the marina office.**

There should be no obstruction to carparking for private residents on Marina Quay.

Hours of operation will be during daylight hours, Monday to Friday.

Members of the public are asked not to loiter in the area nor walk alongside the crane and truck during times of dredging operations for their own safety.
